



Signature Status: What to Know if Your Membership Has Lapsed

(1) CURRENT SIGNATURE MEMBERS WITH LAPSED MEMBERSHIP:

- A. Signature Members are allowed a 60-day grace period for renewal without losing Signature status.
- B. If membership has lapsed fewer than 60 days, you may simply pay the current dues renewal amount on NWWWS.org to retain Signature status.
- C. If membership has lapsed more than 60 days, you owe the current dues renewal amount, plus a one-time \$25.00 reinstatement fee, and the dues amounts for each year of lapsed membership. A special payment arrangement will be made for this circumstance.
- D. Only members in good standing may include “NWWWS” in their signature.

(2) MEMBERS WITH LAPSED DUES APPLYING FOR SIGNATURE STATUS:

- A. If membership has lapsed fewer than 60 days, you pay the \$25.00 Signature application fee plus the dues amounts for each year your membership has lapsed more than 60 days..
- C. Thereafter, the conditions outlined in (1) above apply to all Signature Members.
- D. Only members in good standing may include “NWWWS” in their signature.

(3) NON-NWWWS MEMBER APPLICANTS FOR SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIP:

- A. Non-members may apply for Signature Membership by paying the \$25.00 application fee plus the dues amount for each year dues were not paid between your first qualifying acceptance and your last qualifying acceptance. A special payment arrangement will be made for this circumstance.
- B. Signature Membership requires paying your membership dues every year
- C. Only members in good standing may include “NWWWS” in their signature.
